



COUNCIL NEWS

The Council has scheduled a **Congregational Meeting**, **TODAY**, following our morning worship service. At this meeting we will vote on two matters: 1) our disaffiliation from the CRCNA, and 2) our annual budget. Please remain in prayer for a good discernment on these significant issues. Due to constraints imposed upon us by our bylaws and the Church Order of the CRCNA, absentee ballots will not be accepted at this congregational meeting.

The proposed budget is viewable on a password-protected page at www.calvincrc.org. Call the office if you need the password. Paper copies are on the information table in the Narthex.

As we near the end of the year the Deacons would like to provide a financial update:

- Ministry Fund = \$610,000 through 12/1. \$770,000 is needed to cover annual expenses.
- Missions = \$56,200 through 12/1. \$56,000 is the annual goal.
- Community Care = \$28,200 through 12/1. \$39,500 is the annual goal.
- Family Assistance = \$56,600 through 12/1.
